## AFRICAN-AMERICAN FIRSTS



### Lonnie Bunch III

The First African-American Historian to Serve as the Head of the Smithsonian.

Born on November 18, 1952 in Newark, New Jersey graduated from Bellevue Highschool, attended Howard University and transferred to American University.

Bunch spent most of his career as an educator, museum curator, and held his place as Secretary of the Smithsonian. Overseeing 19 museums, 21 libraries, the National Zoo, numerous research centers, several education units and centers. Previously, in July 2005, he was a Director for the National African American Museum where he had only one staff member, no funds

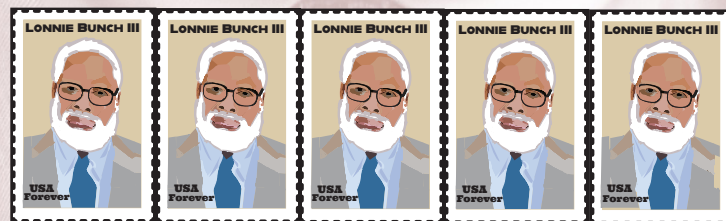
and no site for the museum. The struggles to find the finances and resources took many years. Now the museum documents black history and achievement through a collection of 40,000 artifacts housed in a \$540 million, 400,000-square-foot gallery. He was also a widely published author on topics ranging from the black military experience, the American Presidency & All Black Towns and the Impact of Funding & Politics on American Museums.

Bunch, has a long history of museum divisions involving

community life, documentaries, and preservation of cultures.

His current ventures include a memoir of his time fighting for the National Museum of African American History, titled A Fool's Errand: Creating the N'tnl Museum of African American History and Culture in the Age of Bush, Obama, and Trump, which was published September 24, 2019.

His book offers an in-depth look at Bunch's vision for NMAAHC and providing hints at his vision for the Smithsonian Institution as a whole moving forward.

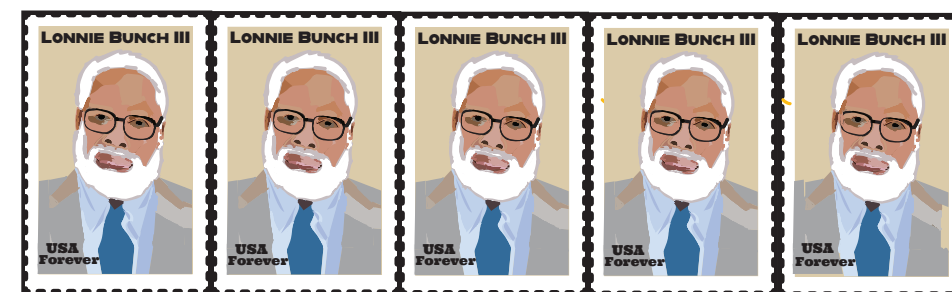
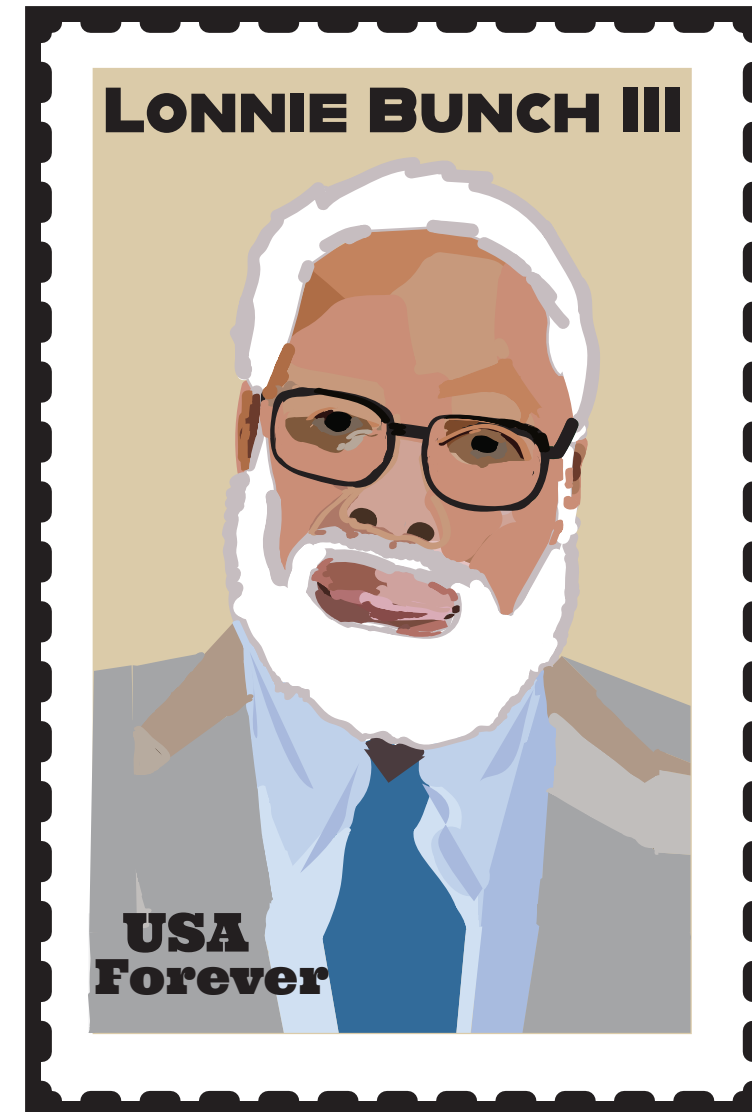


Project Name: 1st African-American Commemorative Stamp Page

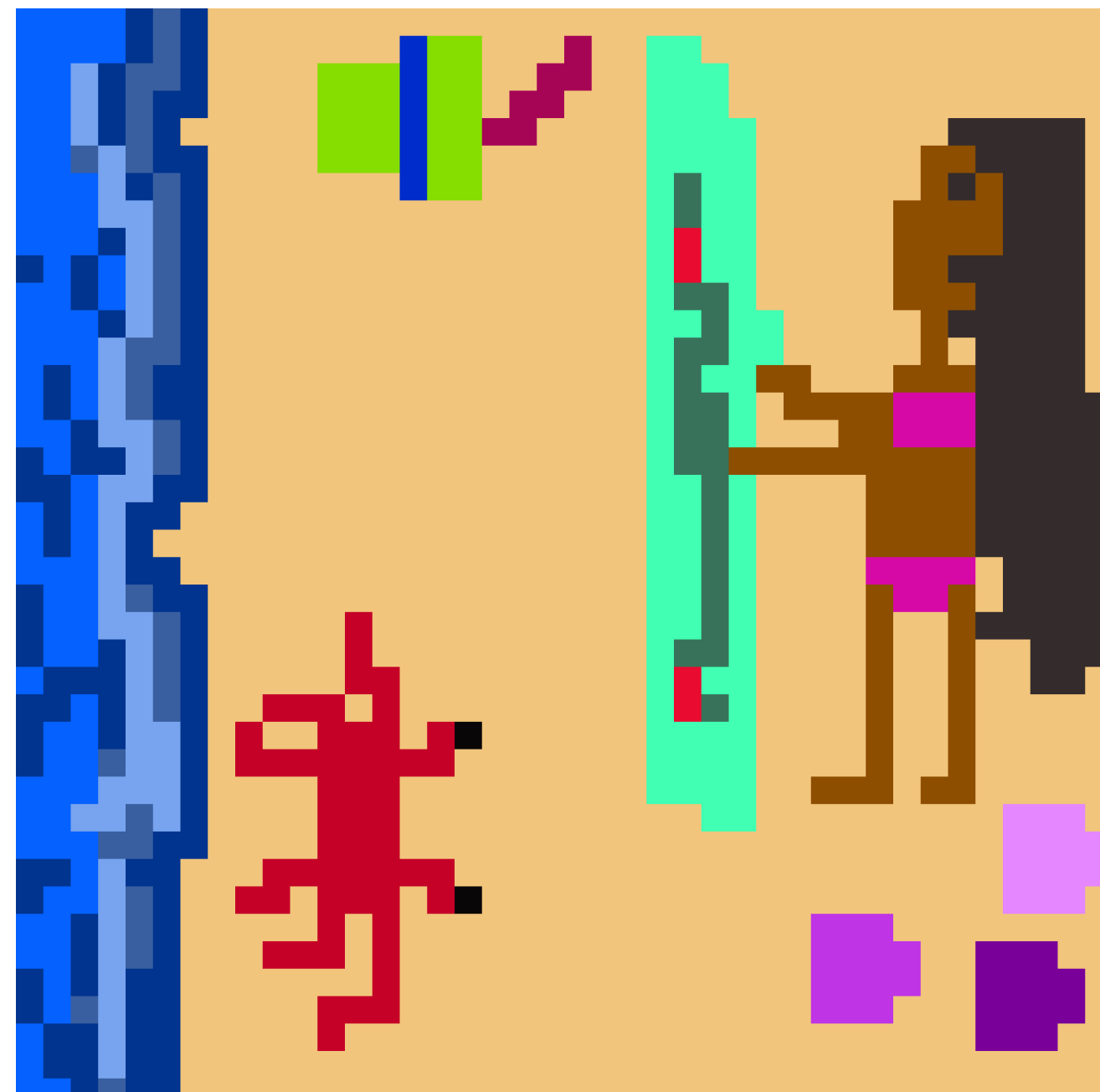

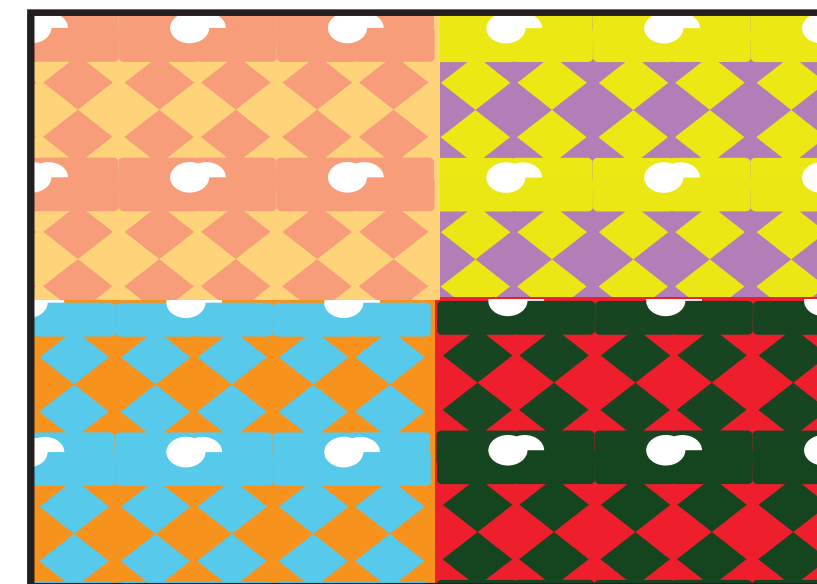
